



Studio Code of Conduct

Attendance

Regular attendance is essential for consistent progress. If your dancer will be absent, please notify the studio as soon as possible.

Punctuality

Dancers should arrive on time and ready to participate. Warm-ups are an important part of class and help reduce the risk of injury. Dancers will be marked late 5 minutes after class start time.

Respect

All dancers, parents, instructors, and staff are expected to treat one another with kindness, respect, and professionalism. Bullying, inappropriate language, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.

Focus & Classroom Behavior

Dancers should listen carefully, follow instructor directions, and remain engaged throughout class. Excessive talking or disruptive behavior may result in sitting out or being dismissed from class.

Dress Code

Dancers are expected to arrive dressed according to the dress code for their class. Proper dancewear allows instructors to safely evaluate technique, alignment, and movement.

Studio Etiquette

Help keep our studio clean and welcoming by disposing of trash properly, respecting studio equipment, and caring for personal belongings. Please leave the studio as you found it.

Food & Drinks

Food, gum, and candy are not permitted inside the dance studios. Dancers with back-to-back classes may enjoy a packed snack or lunch in the designated area between classes. A labeled water bottle is encouraged for all dancers.

Phones & Electronics

Phones, smart watches, and other electronic devices should remain put away during class unless an instructor gives permission to use them.

Parent Communication

To minimize classroom distractions, parents should avoid entering class or interrupting instruction. If you'd like to speak with an instructor, please contact the studio to arrange a convenient time.

Health & Safety

Please keep dancers home if they are experiencing a fever, vomiting, or other contagious illness. Parents should notify the studio of any allergies, injuries, or medical conditions we should be aware of.
